Greetings to All CCAL Members,

Let's get this League year started! The current executive board and committees have met virtually several times to prepare for the start of our 2020-2021 League year. Although we will not be able to meet in person for some time, we will still have virtual meetings and workshops. We thank Barbara Teusink for hosting the ZOOM meetings. The board will meet one week prior to our regular general meeting date. Remember that any member may attend a board meeting, but you will need to let Barbara know ahead of time so she can include you as a ZOOM participant.
