STILL HOPES

Eligibility and Entry Procedures

<u>Eligibility:</u> Participation is open to all CCAL artists in good standing. A member in good standing is one who is current on their dues and has attended three (3) meetings from March 1 to March 1. Artwork must be original and completed within the last 3 years and must not have shown in a previous juried CCAL show (this does not include CCAL Gallery Exhibits, the May contest or non-juried Library exhibits). <u>Artwork created in a workshop setting, with or without the direct help of an instructor, may not be entered into the exhibit. All artists agree to the terms of the CCAL Exhibition Contract by submission of their entry.</u>

Categories:

2D Artwork (oil, watercolor, gouache, acrylic, encaustic, tempera and pastel), drawing (ink, graphite, charcoal, and colored pencil), mixed media, and prints (lino, wood, etching, mono and litho).

Photography - Black & white, color, hand-tinted, digitally altered photographs and computer generated/digitally altered prints.

<u>Size and Condition</u>: Artwork must be completely dry, framed and ready to hang or otherwise suitably prepared for exhibit. Works must have wires – no saw tooth hangers. Unsealed works (water media, pastel, charcoal, ink, etc.) must be framed under glass or Plexiglas. No glass clip picture frames.

Minimum size limitation – 12" x 12" including frame Maximum size limitation – 48" x 48" including frame

<u>Sale of Artwork:</u> A value must be provided for all entered artwork for insurance purposes (or any work to be for sale.) All artwork not for sale must be designated "NFS" during the online entry process. Artwork available for sale will be denoted with the sale price on the wall tag hung with the artwork. Wall tags will include artist contact information for prospective buyers. CCAL will receive a commission of 10% for any artwork sold. <u>Any artwork sold must remain hanging until scheduled pickup date.</u>

Online Entry Guidelines: Artists must fully complete the online entry registration for the exhibition at: crookedcreekart.org/still-hopes-exhibition and pay the non-refundable entry fee. NO ON SITE REGISTRATION. Entry includes online submission of one or two works of art. Artwork images must be formatted vertically or horizontally without frame.

Admission acceptance notifications will be sent to the artist at the email address provided during the online entry process.

<u>Entry Fee:</u> The \$25 non-refundable entry fee entitles each artist to enter one or two two-dimensional works of art.

<u>Liability/Art Pickup</u>: The show will come down on the designated date and <u>all artwork MUST be picked up and signed out at the proper time</u> unless other arrangements have been made with the registrar and/or juried show Chairman. At no time will the Crooked Creek Art League (CCAL) or Still Hopes be responsible for the safety of your artwork. All artwork hangs at the sole risk of the artist. Failure to comply with "pickup" provisions will disqualify a member from participation the following year. Exemption from disqualification may only be determined by the CCAL board of directors.

Crooked Creek Art League reserves the right to accept or reject a work of art not deemed appropriate. Violations of guidelines included in this prospectus will be reviewed by the

Exhibit Committee. <u>Remember that you are hanging in a public place and subject matter must be appropriate</u>. Still Hopes also has the right to remove worked deemed inappropriate for the setting. By entering, artists agree to the use of images of their artwork in promotional materials including, but not limited to, social media, the CCAL website, brochures, advertisements and press releases.

Barbie has taught painting and calligraphy at Midlands Technical College, City Art Gallery, and at The Village Artists Gallery as well as private classes and workshops for individuals and art leagues in South Carolina and throughout the Southeast.

In contributing to this exhibit at Still Hopes, I understand that Still Hopes is not responsible for theft or damage to any items displayed.

Artwork Delivery and Pick Up

Artwork must be delivered to Still Hopes, One Still Hopes Drive, West Columbia, December 3 between 10am and Noon. Assigned drop off times will be staggered and FIRM in order for delivery not to disturb Still Hopes residents' use of the garage which will be the assigned drop off area. We urge car-pooling if possible. If you cannot deliver your work at your assigned time, please arrange with a friend to deliver it for you.

After the show, all artwork must be picked up from Still Hopes on Saturday, January 28, 10 am - Noon. Again, if you cannot pick up during this time, please arrange with a friend to pick up your art. CCAL is not responsible for any artwork not picked up during this time.
