A lot of activities for the project will be happening at CCAL's booth on Clark Street, in the heart of the festival in downtown Chapin. Here's how you can participate:

- Download the app, and bid at Accelevents.com/e/TheArtsTrailThrough Chapin. The trail markers will be auctioned off via this app on Monday, Sept 6. You can bid from your phone and keep up with competing bids as you enjoy your day. Bidders do not have to be present to bid or to win. Bidding ends at 2pm on Monday. Winners should plan to pick up their trail markers at the booth by 3pm.

## The Art Trails Through Chapin Scavenger Hunt The Jelcome to


