There are lots of places to choose from with varying lengths of display time as well as how many pieces each can accept. Our last meeting of the league year will be on Monday, May 19, and our May contest will be held during this time. Members are invited to bring one piece of artwork, along with an easel to display their art during our meeting. The theme for the artwork should relate to “Childhood Memories.” ***There is no cost to enter, but you will need to register your entry on the website by May 16, prior to the meeting.*** Ribbons will be awarded to the top three winners. This is a fun meeting and a great way to end our league year. Artwork that is submitted will also remain at Crooked Creek Park in our TAP Gallery throughout the summer. Registration for the exhibition at the Irmo Branch Library has been extended until Monday, April 21. If you would like to exhibit, and possibly sell your artwork, please go online to review the prospectus. Because we are past the original date to register, the online registration site has been closed and is unable to be accessed by members. To register your artwork during the extension period, please email our Library Show coordinator, Cathy Schwalm, to let her know of your intent. Please send your email to Cathy at creatvcat29@aol.com and be sure to include the following:

1. A photograph of your entry (not to include the frame).
2. A sale price. Please indicate if your art is for sale or not for sale.
3. The size of your artwork.
4. The medium.
5. Artist name, email address, and telephone number.
6. Title of artwork.

You may enter one or two pieces of artwork. The cost is \$5.00 per entry. This may be paid to Cathy when you bring your art to the library on Saturday, April 26. Cathy will also have copies of the library's waiver for you to sign at that time. Artwork will be on display April 26 – May 30. This is a non-juried show so you may enter art that you have shown in previous shows. A People's Choice Award winner will be determined and awarded a ribbon and bragging rights.

If you like to plan ahead, you might want to think about signing up now for our workshop to be held September 26-27: "Painting 'Painterly' from a Photo Reference" with Dan Graziano. This will be a wonderful workshop and one you won't want to miss. To find out more information and to register, please visit our website and look under Events - Workshops.
