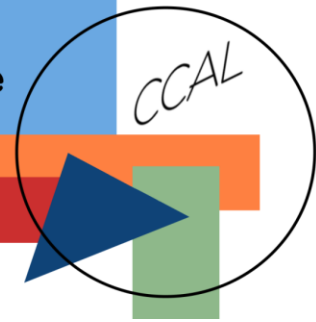

Time is winding down for our Crooked Creek Art League year. This year has flown by (as it usually does) and we are preparing for our final events before summer arrives. Our 29th Annual Juried Show and reception were a huge success. We had a total of 65 artists who entered 152 total pieces of artwork. It was fun to be able to walk the building and see all the wonderful artwork by our members. A special note of congratulations to all our award winners!

Thank you to all who helped with the various needs of the show as well as the reception night. We wouldn't be able to do everything without our volunteers! Thank you also to our Juried Show co-chairs, Sonya Diimmler and Siara Pineda for their work throughout the year to prepare for this wonderful show! We had a total of 67 members, 65 guests, and 7 on Zoom in attendance for our show reception, for a total of 139 participants.

Hurry to register if you plan to participate. Delivery of artwork will be held on Saturday, April 27, 10:00am-noon. Remember to bring a signed copy of the waiver when you come.
- Membership renewal for the upcoming 2024-2025 league year is now open. A reminder that the dues for general membership have increased to \$35 per year. Patron level remains at \$50. Dues must be paid by September 30 to avoid a \$10 late fee.

- The last meeting of the league year will be May 20. In lieu of a speaker we will be having our “Annual May Contest.” The theme for the contest is “Sights from Around the World.” Please go online to register your artwork and read the prospectus for details. Deadline to register is May 17. Members are asked to bring one piece of original artwork along with an easel for display purposes at the meeting. Members present in person will vote for their favorites and ribbons will be awarded. After the meeting, all the artworks will be exhibited in the TAP Gallery and remain there throughout the summer. Let’s have a great end-of-year celebration by having many pieces of artwork by many members!
- We will also be collecting donations of art supplies for the Epworth Children’s Home at our May meeting. Let’s all see if we can find some art supplies the children will enjoy!
