The Sailboats will be displayed at their current host sites through the end of September and will be featured in the Town's Labor Day Festival on Monday Sept 2, 2019.

Lots of activities for the project will be happening at CCAL's booth on Labor Day! Come see us on Clark Street near Beaufort Street in downtown Chapin.

Celebrating 25 Years Crooked Creek Art League

In 1995 a small group joined together in Chapin, South Carolina to encourage and stimulate the practice and appreciation of creative arts, to educate and encourage each other's work as well as to assist with the growth of visual arts in the community. This small group became known as Crooked Creek Art League (CCAL).

Today, Crooked Creek Art League consists of approximately 120 members. The League includes professional and amateur artists and artisans - painters of all mediums, photographers, sculptors and mixed media artists.

Meeting every third Monday of the month, September - May at Crooked Creek Park, members welcome presenters offering exploration in various mediums to encourage creativity, attend workshops offered for all levels of expertise to expand artistic skills, have the opportunity to submit original art pieces to an annual juried show and may display artwork at partnered public galleries throughout the midlands.

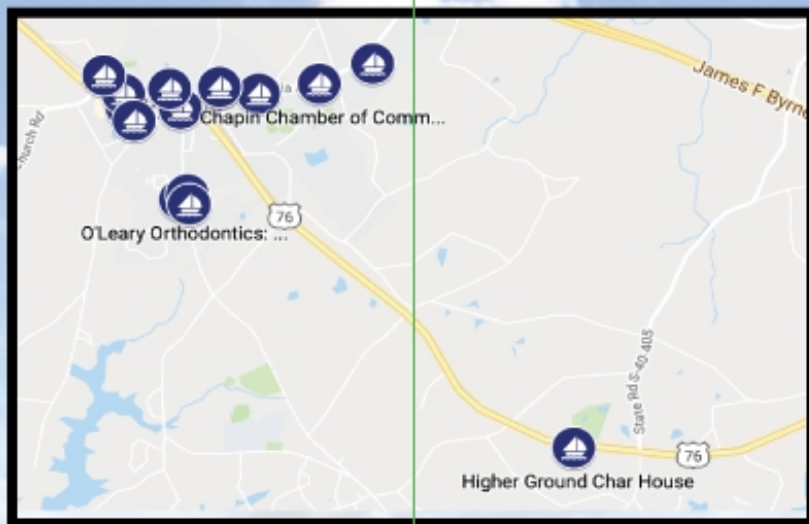

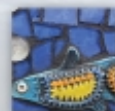
