Our presenter for the meeting will be Mary Presson Roberts. Her presentation, "Follow Your Own Path," revolves around her journey in the art and photography world. Mary is an excellent speaker, and you won't want to miss hearing from her.

Our TAP Gallery theme for the next month is "Scenes from the Past." Bring your original artwork to the meeting this Monday to be displayed in the Crooked Creek Park foyer until February 17. Remember to print your wall tag to attach to your artwork. Let's provide many pieces of artwork to showcase for all the people who come to the park each day.

Our Annual Juried Show is coming up soon; online only registration is open through February 20. You can find the prospectus and all other information regarding the show on our website. The reception for the show will be held on Saturday, March 15. We are still in need of more volunteers to help with

setting up for the reception, bringing food, cleaning up, and setting up for the program, as well as pick up day for the artwork. If you are able to help in any way, please add your name to the sign-up forms on the table as you check in for the meeting. There is no cost to enter but you just need to prepare your artwork, ***register it on the website by May 16***, and bring it to our Monday, May 19 meeting. Also bring an easel to the meeting to display your artwork so all the members present can easily view and vote on their favorites. Ribbons will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>- 3<sup>rd</sup> place. This is a fun contest and a chance to see how everyone interprets “Childhood Memories.” Artwork that is submitted will also remain on display at Crooked Creek Park throughout the summer.

At our last board meeting it was decided that we would go to an **Online Only** league registration for new members as well as for membership renewal of dues. Most members already renew online so it won't be a big change. It will, however, help us keep track of the membership dues easier with online only registration and payment. We will remind everyone about this when it is time to start renewing again.

We have a lot going on with the league from now until the end of May, and it takes an army to make it all happen. Consider volunteering where needed, especially for our upcoming Annual Juried Show.
