A Community Art Project

This collaborative community art project between the Crooked Creek Art League (CCAL) and the Town of Chapin will add color to an already dynamic Chapin arts scene. Artful Turtles showcase the work of 15 local artists. This highly anticipated public art project includes a community scavenger hunt and auction culminating at the 2024 Chapin Labor Day Festival.

The art consists of 15 locally-designed and crafted fiberglass turtles. The turtles are on display at sponsoring businesses for the Scavenger Hunt July 2 – August 31 and will be sold via silent auction on September 2 at the Chapin Labor Day Festival. The public will be able to bid on the turtles even if not present. A portion of the proceeds will be given to the artist and the remaining portion will be used to produce future community art projects.

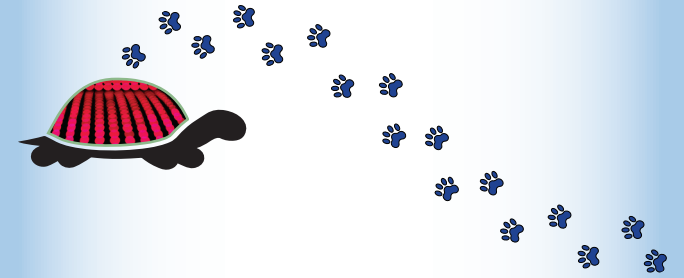

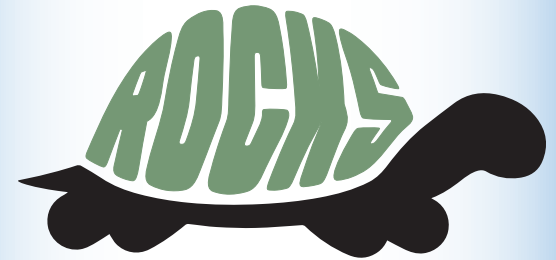
