

The Legacy of Art Memorial Award

1. All currently enrolled members who pass will be honored in the CCAL shows and exhibitions. This award will be called the “Legacy of Art Memorial Award”, one award honoring all members who died since the last Annual Juried Show.
2. The names of each member who died in the previous league year will be listed under the Legacy of Art Memorial Award acknowledgement in juried shows and exhibition programs (currently the Spring Annual Show and the Still Hopes Exhibition).
3. Existing memorial accounts with a balance of less than \$500 on December 1, 2025, will be moved to the Legacy of Art Memorial Award account.
4. Beginning in 2026, the award amount for the annual “Legacy of Art Memorial Award” will be \$100 (one award unless otherwise stipulated by the Board).

Individual Memorial Award

5. *Existing individual memorial accounts with at least \$500 as of Dec. 1, 2025, will be grandfathered, as an individual memorial award, until such time they are unable to sustain the designated award amount. Once the grandfather account is no longer able to support the designated award amount, the remaining funds will be transferred to the Legacy of Art award account.*
6. Beginning in 2026, the award amount will be \$100 for each *individual award*.
7. With the approval of the board, memorial donations made in the amount of \$500 or greater may be used to establish a new individual award in the deceased member’s name. For each individual memorial fund, \$100 will be awarded annually until the account drops below \$100. At that time, the remaining amount will be moved into the Legacy of Art Award account. Additional donations in any amount may be used to supplement the balance in an existing individual memorial fund at the request of the donor.

Memorial Award Administrative Guidelines

8. Upon notification of a member’s death, the CCAL Executive Committee of the Board will confirm the death and will authorize the name to be added to Memorial Giving page on the CCAL website.
9. Donations may be made via the Memorial Giving page, found on the CCAL website: <https://crookedcreekartleague.com/memorial-giving>.
 - a. Donations may be made in any amount for the Legacy of Art Memorial Award.
 - b. Initial donations to establish a new individual memorial award must be \$500 or greater.
 - c. Donations may be made in any amount to supplement existing individual memorial award funds.

10. At the February Executive Committee Meeting every year, the CCAL Treasurer shall report on the total amount of funds in the “Legacy of Art Memorial Award” account. If there is at least \$100 in that account, the Legacy Award will be given as part of the Spring Annual Show. If the account is less than \$100, the Executive Committee may vote to still offer this award using other funding sources since the last Annual Juried Show. The amount of the award shall be \$100 annually. If no member deaths occur in that timeframe, the Executive Committee has the authority to authorize the award be offered anyway if funding is available.
11. If the legacy account is greater than \$1,000 on February 1, the CCAL Executive Committee may consider increasing the amount of the Legacy award or the number of Legacy awards to be given in that year’s annual show.
